# What is Welcome To Bradford?

Welcome To Bradford is HALE's support scheme for Refugees and Asylum Seekers.

Welcome To Bradford aims to:

- Improve mental health

# How can Welcome To Bradford help me?

A HALE Networker can visit clients and provide practical support by:

- Making appointments and helping to get there
- Translating letters/making phone calls
- Finding English classes
- Finding voluntary work
- Finding local activities
- Opening bank accounts
- Raising awareness of rights/benefits/grants
- Finding nursery places
- Providing toys/clothes
- Signposting to relevant services

# How does it work?

Referrals can be made by calling HALE on 01274 271088.

Self referrals are also accepted.

Once a referral is received a Networker will visit the client in their own home.

The Networker will visit up to 6 times, until the client feels confident enough to support themselves.
