



Relationships, Sex and Health Education Support in Bradford Schools

This programme is commissioned by Bradford Council Until March 2023, and will be delivered by a new collaboration between Step 2, JAMES Project and HALE.

The partnership is made up of three voluntary sector agencies who have over 30 years' experience of work in Bradford/Keighley schools, and have been involved with relationships and sex education and supporting young people with their sexual health for over 20 years.

The programme will offer a flexible approach to developing a formula for supporting schools with their RSE delivery, working closely with the RSE leads, and involving all stakeholder groups (including young people, parents and local community groups), helping them to successfully achieve the statutory requirements, whilst delivering according to the needs of the school and student population, with removal of any barriers to delivery.

You will be joining a multi professional team, who will be supported by organisations who have for many years been involved of the development of RSE within Bradford schools.

The programme will include

- a universal offer, benefitting all mainstream secondary schools
- comprehensive support to schools with additional needs/ in hot spot areas.
- Consultation with school staff, parents, young people and communities to ensure relevant and culturally sensitive delivery.
- Access to the URChoice programme, which has been developed in partnership with schools and health professionals over a number of years.
- Development of the current URChoice programme, and the creation of additional resources, to ensure it is relevant and engaging
- Classroom delivery of the programme to ensure dynamic and engaging delivery.
- Training of school staff to deliver the programme in partnership.
